We would love you to learn memory verses, complete Bible-based activities, and send these in to a teacher - just like a real Sunday school.

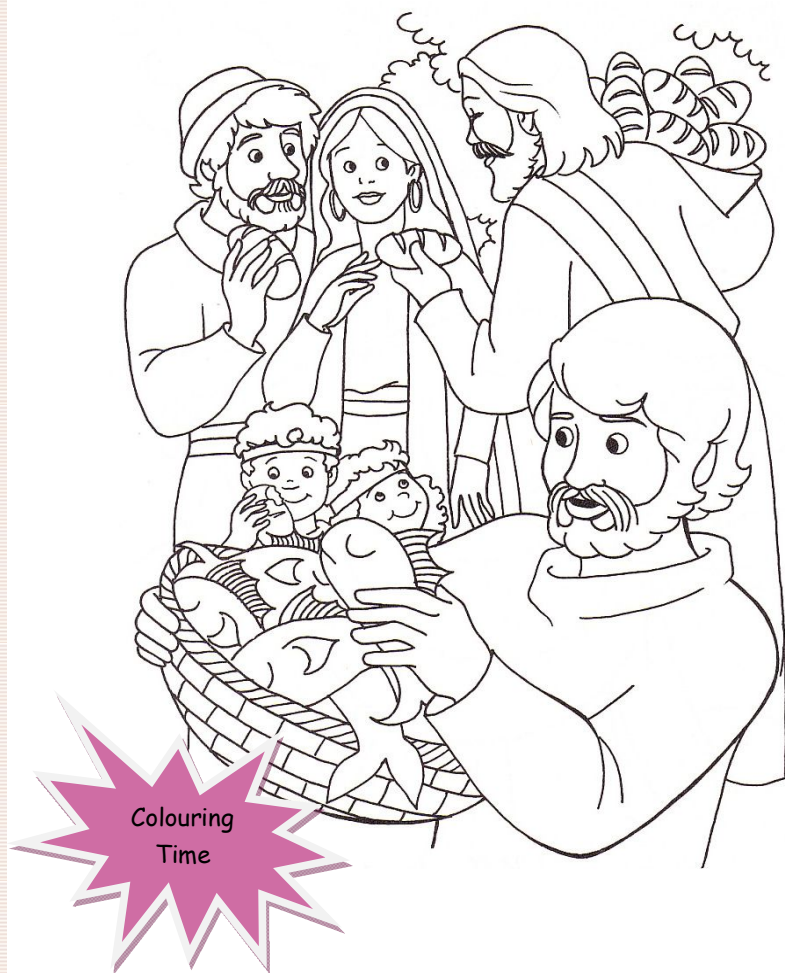
- Ask your Mum or Dad to scan your completed e-lesson and send it to info@God-is.net
