

Zacchaeus was a sinner, just like you and me, but Jesus still loved him Read about it in **Luke 19 v 1-10**.

In the city of Jericho, there was a man called Zacchaeus. He was very important and rich but he was very short and not well liked by the people of Jericho. One day, he heard that Jesus was passing through the city so he ran out to see the Son of God. However, Zacchaeus was so little that he couldn't see Jesus over the heads of the people in front of him! He really wanted to see Him so when he spotted a big sycamore tree that Jesus would be passing under, he ran ahead and climbed the tree. When Jesus walked under the tree, He looked up and saw Zacchaeus and told him to come down quickly, for He wanted to go Zacchaeus' house. Zacchaeus was delighted and they went to his house. The people saw this and were very upset, saying that Jesus was a guest with a man that was a sinner.

Zacchaeus told the Lord that he would give half of his goods to the poor and anything that he had stolen from another person would be given back four times over!
