Read about it in **Genesis 1**.

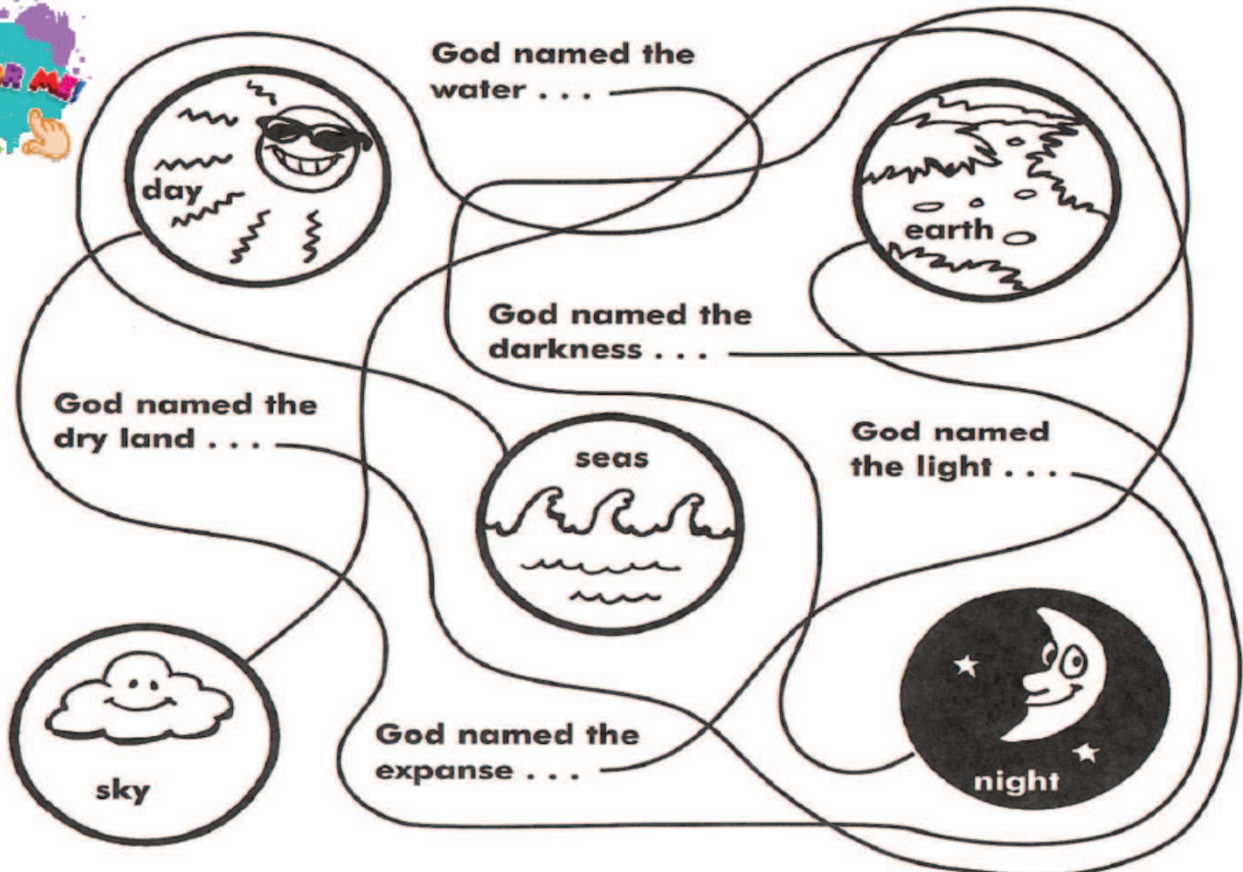
