Abraham obeys God.

Read the story in Genesis 12 & 13.

When Noah and his family went out of the ark, they were given a special blessing from God. He told them to 'go forth and multiply'. They were to have many children and fill the earth with them. That is just what they did! Noah's three children, Shem, Ham and Japheth each had children, and their children had more children, so that soon the earth began to fill up with people again. It was with one of the descendants of Shem that God began to work.

Do you know that God takes a special interest in us? Not everyone who hears God's voice will listen to Him and obey Him? He calls everyone in this world to repent of their sins and trust His Son for salvation, but only a very few people listen to His voice and turn to the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation. God does not speak to us in an audible voice that we can hear with our ears, but through His Spirit, and through His working in our lives, so that we can come to know that we need to trust His Son as our Saviour.

Abraham listened to God. God had a special message for him. He told Abraham to leave the land where he was living, leave his father's house and go to a new land that God would show to him. Would you have obeyed God? Abraham trusted God. He knew that God knew what was best for him, and he was happy to obey, so he packed up his family and his animals and left Haran, as God had told him to do. He took Lot, his nephew, with him. Abraham had many children, became a very wealthy man, and God really blessed him.

God blesses those who trust in Him, who believe Him, and obey His Word. Do you know one of the blessings we receive when we believe in His Son? It is that we can have our sins forgiven and live forever in Heaven. God tells us: 'The gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord' (Romans 6 v 23).

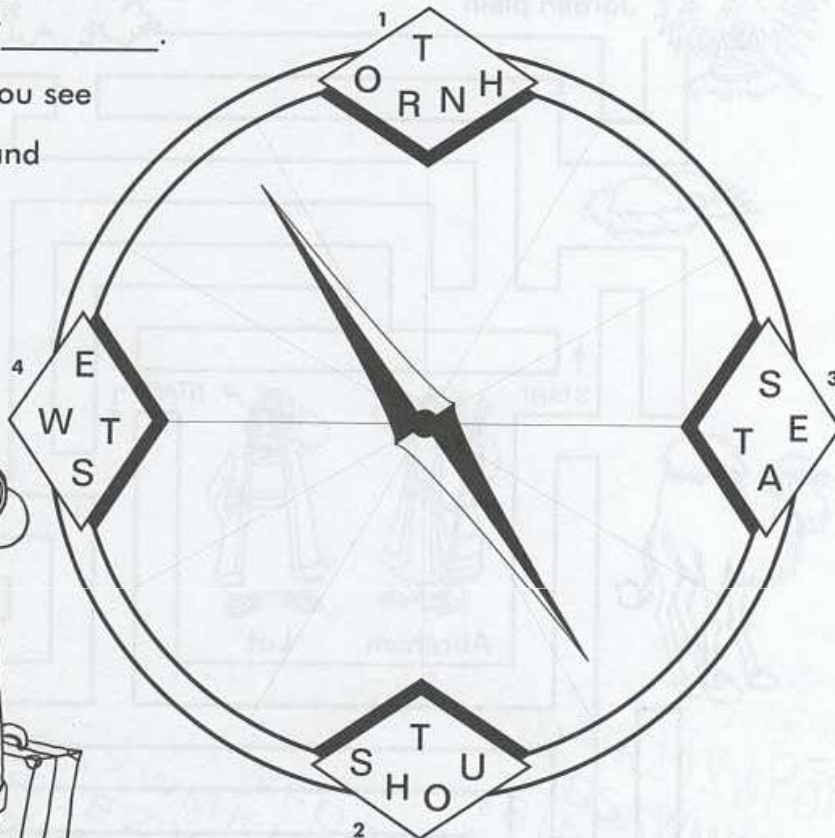
PUZZLE TIME
