What if it is true after all?



The fact is - God is!

2 Peter 3 v 3, 4

We will be held accountable for our actions, for

God 'hath appointed a day, in which He will judge the world in righteousness'.

Acts 17 v 31

If God is real, what does He want from me?

He wants a personal relationship with you.

God loved you so much that He sent His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to the cross to suffer for your sins, to take away your sin, and to free you from it.

To face up to the existence of God means to face up to your sin, but also to find out that God sent His Son to die for sinners like you.

'He was wounded for our transgressions. He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed'.

Isaiah 53 v 5
